### **Pierre Keller Visiting Professorship at Harvard University**

The Pierre Keller Visiting Professorship provides an opportunity for a scholar with a well-established record of work and academic achievement in the field of European Union affairs and transatlantic relations to do research at Harvard University's Weatherhead Center for International Affairs (WCFIA) from January to June 2017. The recipient would also teach a course at the Harvard Kennedy School of Government during the 2017 Spring term on an EU-related subject of her/his choosing.

The professorship provides a stipend of 60,000 USD (plus benefits) and covers transatlantic travel expenses of up to 2,000 USD.

Applications should be sent by email not later than February 21, 2016 to Manuel Muñiz, Director of the Program on Transatlantic Relations at the WCFIA ([mmuniz@wcfia.harvard.edu](mailto:mmuniz@wcfia.harvard.edu)), consisting of a description of the research project to be pursued at Harvard (of not more than 3 pages), a CV and a list of publications as well as a draft syllabus of the course the applicant proposes to teach at the Kennedy School.

For the 2017 Professorship the selection committee will only consider applications from individuals from the following countries: Albania, Bosnia, Croatia, Italy, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Portugal, Serbia, Slovenia, and Spain.
