The submission deadline for PhD papers and abstracts will be the 15th of April, and students will receive notice of acceptance/rejection before May 1st.

PhD students whose paper is accepted for presentation will be invited to attend the PhD session at no further cost, and they can attend the conference for the reduced fee mentioned below.
